## Youth of the Month



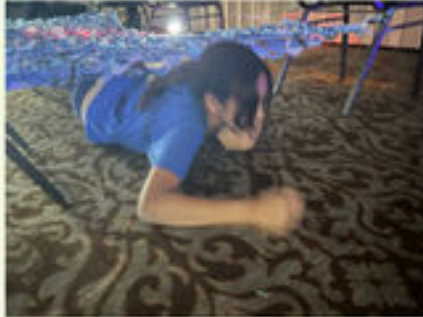
**Ananiah Cain**
